Section 3.75 (c) (1) (i) states - "Any surfaces that come in contact with nonhuman primates must: (i) Be free of excessive rust that prevents the required cleaning and sanitization."

OE-20: There were enrichment devices inside NHP enclosures that were secured to the side panels of the
enclosures with either metal chains or metal clasps. The surfaces of some of the chains and clasps were noted to be
rusty. The NHPs would come in direct contact with the chains and clasps whenever they climbed on or handled the
enrichment devices. This affected 6 NHPs.

The presence of rust on surfaces can interfere with the required cleaning and sanitization practices. The Registrant corrected this item during the inspection by removing the rusty metal chains and clasps from the enrichment devices and then replacing them with brand new chains and clasps.

NOTE - This was a focused inspection based on the non-compliant items identified at the time of the last full facility inspection conducted June 23-24, 2010. The research facility has undertaken corrective actions and all of the non-compliant items that were identified on the 6/23/10 inspection report have either been corrected or corrective actions are in progress in order to meet the correction dates that were assigned.
